Who May Enter: Only Edmond Quilt Guild (EQG) members in good standing may enter items into the show. Members CANNOT enter a non-member's quilt under the member's name. EQG membership is required to submit a quilt entry form. EQG dues must have been paid by February 2016 for the member's quilt to be included in the show.

Quilts entered in previous EQG shows are ineligible to compete.

Judging: This is a judged show. Items that you enter will be judged unless they are entered in a non-judged category.

Number of Entries: Members may enter up to three items, using a separate entry form for each item. You may copy the *Quilt Entry Information* form. Special Exhibits do not count as an item.

Category Placement: Please indicate on the *Quilt Entry Information* form the category for your item. A list of categories is attached for easy reference. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to make the final decision on the entry of quilts, their category, and where the quilts will be hung.

Awards: In each category, First, Second and Third place ribbons will be awarded by the judge. Additional Honorable Mentions may be awarded. First Place in each category will be eligible for Best of Show. Best Hand Quilting, Viewers' Choice, Judge's Choice and Founder Awards will also be given.

Insurance: Members are responsible for insuring items as desired. Check your homeowner's policy for coverage details.

Quilt Sleeve: ALL quilts must have a 4-inch deep finished sleeve attached to the back of the quilt. *The top of the sleeve must be no more than 90" from the bottom of the quilt.* Quilts without appropriate sleeves will not be accepted.

Quilt Label: All quilts must have a fabric identification label sewn to the lower right-hand corner of the quilt (as you look at the back). This label must have the member's name and the name of the quilt.

Entry Photos: Color photos of entries must be attached to the entry forms. 35mm and high-resolution digital prints will be accepted. You may also e-mail your entry forms with a digital photo to: WonderLand48@cox.com. Quilt entry forms and photos will not be returned to the member.

Permission to Photograph: Each quilt entry must have a signed *Permission to Photograph* form, which is located at the bottom of the *Quilt Story* form.

Quilt Story: The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to edit the quilt story for length and spelling.

Late entries will not be accepted.

Quilt Drop-Off: Quilts must be delivered between June 24 and July 1, 2016, to either Alice Kellogg (2805 Old Farm Rd., Edmond; 348-2233), Judy Elliott (1309 Copperfield Dr., Edmond; 715-0216), Sue Esparza (11320 Wolf Creek Rd. North Edmond or Guthrie; 206-2328) or Brenda Esslinger (3428 N.W. 26, OKC; 946-0817). **Safety pin** the *Quilt Identification* form to the right-hand side of the back of the quilt, just above the label. DO NOT USE STRAIGHT PINS! Entries should be individually placed into a cloth bag, such as a pillowcase, with your name on the outside of the bag in large, readable block letters.

Quilt Pick-Up: Keep the *Permission to Pick Up Entered Item* form until the close of the show on Saturday. No quilt will be released without this form. Quilts will be available for pick up after 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 9, 2016.

Step 2: Prepare your quilt(s) for the show

- Attach a 4-inch finished sleeve to the back of the quilt
- Attach a fabric identification label to the back of the quilt

Step 3: Turn in your quilt(s)

deadline between June 24 and July 1, 2016

- Fill in the Quilt Identification form and attach it to the back of your quilt
- Deliver quilt(s), each in a separate bag, to Alice Kellogg (2805 Old Farm Rd., Edmond; 348-2233), Judy Elliott (1309 Copperfield Dr., Edmond; 715-0216), Sue Esparza (11320 Wolf Creek Rd. Guthrie or North, Edmond; 206-2328) or Brenda Esslinger (3428 N.W. 26, OKC; 946-0817)

Step 4: Pick up your quilt(s)

- Fill out the Permission to Pick Up Entered Item form
- Bring the completed form on Saturday, July 26 after 6:00 p.m. to pick up your quilt(s) and take it/them home

NOTE: Any quilts not picked up by 7:00p.m. Saturday will become the property of the Quilt Show Committee, who will take them home and really enjoy using them!

Definitions:

Masters – Anyone who has been awarded 3 Blue Ribbons in the same category, and/or received a Best of Show Ribbon. Anyone who has received a National Award.

Mixed Technique – Two or more dominant techniques including to and not limited to appliqué, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, machine or hand quilting. A quilt that doesn't fall into any of the major categories.

Pictorial Quilts – The quilt is a representation of a person, place, or thing.

Art & Innovative – Quilts reflecting the original creativity of the artist. Traditional design elements may be incorporated, but only in an innovative manner. Art quilts are original designs

Group Quilt – A quilt that contains blocks or work that was contributed by a number of people, such as a small quilting group, a round-robin exchange, or an internet block exchange.

First Time Entry – An entrant who has never entered any quilt show previously.

Modern Quilts -- Hard to define but according to the [Modern Quilt Guild](#), these include: the use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work. 'Modern traditionalism' or the updating of classic quilt designs is also often seen in modern quilting."

Size – In categories with Large and Small only, Large will be 240 and up, Small 239 and down, on the outside perimeter. Small scale quilts, 100 and under.

Note: If any category has less than 5 entries the show committee will reassign the quilt into another appropriate category.

Any category that should require further delineation will be divided into Small, Medium, and Large. The above is subject to change depending on the amount of entries and some categories may be combined.
