Note: If any category has less than 5 entries the show committee may reassign the quilt into another appropriate category. The entrant will be notified of the change.

Awards

First, Second, Third Place and Honorable Mention awards will be given at the Judges' discretion in each category.

Special Awards: Best Hand Quilting; Best of Show; Founder's Award; Judges Choice (2) and Viewers' Choice.

DEFINITIONS:

Applique – Quilts where the predominant technique, over 50% is hand and/or machine applique.

Art & Pictorial Quilts – The quilt is a representation of a person, place, or thing.

Block of the Month or Kits: A quilt made from fabrics and pattern pre-selected by a third party in which the majority of design decisions have been made for the quilter. These quilts are judged only on workmanship and will not be eligible for any special awards.

First Time Entry – An entrant who has never entered any quilt show previously. A very brave person who should be congratulated.

Group Quilt – A quilt that contains blocks or work that was contributed by a number of people (3 or more), such as a small quilting group, a round-robin exchange, or an internet block exchange.

Innovative – An Innovative quilt design is one that uses a new interpretation of a traditional pattern. It uses new techniques, a unique arrangement or a different use of traditional material. It illustrates a significant change from traditional designs.

Masters – Anyone who has been awarded 3 Blue Ribbons regardless of category, and/or received a Best of Show Ribbon. Anyone who has received a National Award.

Mixed Technique – Three or more techniques including applique, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, machine or hand quilting. A quilt that doesn't fall into any of the major categories.

Size – In categories with Large and Small- Large will be 240 and larger. Small 239 and smaller, measured on the outside perimeter. These guidelines may be changed at the discretion of the show committee.

Small Scale Quilts – A smaller quilt. Outside dimensions should not exceed 100 inches.
