

# EQG BLOCK LOTTERY #2

The next block exchange will be a Churn Dash block. (Some call it “Hole in the Barn Door”.) A variation on a 9-patch, this block includes half-square triangles and pieced units. Finished size will be 9” square – that means 9 ½ “ unfinished.

## Materials:

Scraps of cream and scraps of a “fall color” print.

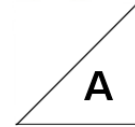
## Cutting:

### **From cream, cut:**

- 2 (3 7/8”) squares. Cut in half diagonally to make 4 A triangles.
- 4 (2” x 3 ½ “) rectangles to make 4 C rectangles.
- 1 (3 ½”) square for center B.

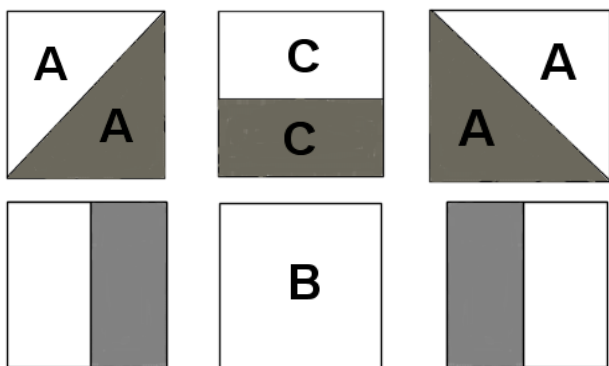
### **From fall color print, cut:**

- 2 (3 7/8”) squares. Cut in half diagonally to make 4 A triangles.
- 4 (2” x 3 ½”) rectangles to make 4 C rectangles.



## Assembly:

1. Join 1 print triangle A and 1 cream triangle A along long edges to make a square. Repeat to make a total of 4 squares.
2. Join 1 cream rectangle C and 1 print rectangle C along long edges to make a square. Repeat to make total of 4 squares.
3. Referring to *Block Assembly Diagram*, join 2 A units to 1 C unit. Repeat. Join 1 C unit to each side of square B. Join rows to complete block.
