Fellow quilters,

When I began quilting in 1989 the whole idea of a quilt retreat was new to me and I think new to a lot of people. My first retreat was with a small group to Ponca City. We stayed on the grounds of the Marlin Mansion in an old convent. We had a huge room to sew in and we all were taught a design from a book called "Square Dance." It was a simple enough pattern, but the ending results were strikingly unique and we could see first hand how important fabric choice was to design results. Not only did we have fun, we loved being able to sew for hours on end without the need to answer the phone, check the mailbox, throw in a load of laundry or start dinner. The only distractions were wondering what was so funny on the other side of the room when there was an outburst of laughter. I'll never forget the time one afternoon when the room was momentarily quiet and one woman (I'm not naming names) spoke up and asked the group of about 20 women who had *all* brought their *entire* sewing rooms, "Does anyone in the room have a needle and thread?" It took us hours to recover from that.

Retreats are great. I simply love the synergy that's generated when a group of like-minded people come together to share their gifts and talents with one another. We all come with different levels of experience and all with our own likes and dislikes. But the important thing is that we have more in common than differences and it begins with our love for quilting and takes off from there.

4. You'll understand the magic of a sweatshop.





4. You may keep all leftover challenge fabric scraps.
5. All completed quilts will be due for judging by all EQG members at the **OCTOBER** meeting.
6. All completed challenge quilts will be donated to the Hope Center.
7. First place winner will receive a **\$50 gift certificate** from Sooner Quilts in Guthrie. Second place winner will receive a **\$25 gift certificate** from Toadally Awesome Quilting by Brenda Esslinger.


